



Familycare offers food vouchers, practical advice, referrals to specific organisations, such as Homeswest, Department for Community Services, etc, counselling for relationship, personal and family problems. Personal growth and enrichment courses are also offered occasionally.

A Natural Family Planning teacher and Pregnancy Help counsellors are available, and an Aboriginal worker who offers assistance, liaison for Aboriginals with authorities, family support and a soup kitchen.

Familycare services are available for all.

THE OLD GAOL

This old building stands in the grounds of the Bill Sewell Complex. It was built in 1858 by John Wilson and William Stokes at a cost of 620 pounds and was used as a prison until 1984.

The Gaol was left vacant until 1989 when a group of craftspeople banded together and took it upon themselves to clean up and restore this old building and make it into the tourist attraction it is today.

The empty cells are rented out to practising craftspeople and over 70,000 people have viewed the Old Gaol since it opened to the public in April 1989.

Members of The Old Gaol Craft Centre Inc with the help of local sponsors have just finished restoring the Historic Champion Bay Well. This well supplied a large part of Geraldton with water before the turn of the century. This well is in the front lawn of our old gaol.

The full history of the Old Gaol is framed and hangs on the passage walls. A visit into our past history and meeting our local craftspeople is a must on your visit to Geraldton.






