

The following Conditions of Entry applies for the well-being and safeguard of City of Greater Geraldton Regional Library users and staff. Users of this venue are encouraged to accept responsibility for the appropriate care of the facilities, services and resources.

By entering the Library, you as the user agree to the Conditions of Entry.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By entering this venue, you agree to abide by these conditions:

Respect: Treat all users including Library staff with courtesy and respect.

Behaviour: Users must behave in a responsible, safe and lawful manner. Running, swearing, the use of abusive language, violent conduct, theft or malicious damage within the Library shall not be tolerated. If a user's behaviour causes a public disturbance or nuisance, the users will be required to leave the Library.

Conversation is welcome, but all users need to be mindful of others as the Library is a shared space.

Instructions: Follow instructions and directions given by library staff.

Library Resources: Use library materials, equipment and furniture with respect and for designated purposes only.

Children: Children under the age of 12 are to be supervised at all times. Library staff are not responsible for the supervision of children.

Dress: Appropriate dress is required. This includes the wearing of footwear and shirt/top.

Belongings: The Library takes no responsibility for your personal belongings. Please ensure you keep/attend to them at all times.

Use of Vehicles: Scooters, bikes, skateboards, roller-skates, rollerblades or other similar items are not permitted to be ridden in the building. Items left in the foyer are at the owner's risk.

Intoxication: People using the Library must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Smoking: Users are advised that smoking is strictly prohibited in the Library or within 5 metres of all library entrances.

Signage: Users must comply with all posted signage within the Library.

IMPORTANT NOTE: All users must abide by the COVID-19 specific Conditions of Entry as per the Western Australian Government Law. These conditions may change periodically. The link to the latest version can always be found on the Library webpage, library.cgg.wa.gov.au.

Library staff have the right to ask any user to leave the Library if they do not comply with these Conditions of Entry as per *Library Board (Registered Public Libraries) Regulations Part III, 1985 (WA)* and the *City of Greater Geraldton Public Places and Local Government Property Local Law 2020*.
