

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



MEMBERSHIP

Library membership is free and open to all Australian residents.



SUPERVISION

Children under 12 must be supervised at all times. It is parents/guardians' responsibility to monitor the suitability of library resources used by their children.



RESOURCES

Use library materials, equipment and furniture with respect and for their designated purpose.



RESPECT

Treat all users including Library staff with courtesy and respect.



BEHAVIOUR

No running, swearing or disruptive behaviour. Follow instructions and directions given by Library staff.



VEHICLES

No scooters, bikes or similar items inside, except when used for mobility e.g. gophers.



SUBSTANCES

People using the Library must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.



BELONGINGS

The Library takes no responsibility for your personal belongings.



SMOKING/VAPING

Smoking and vaping is strictly prohibited in the Library or within 5 metres of the entrance.



CLEANLINESS

Keep our Library clean. Tidy up after yourself and use the bins provided to you by the Library.



DRESS CODE

Appropriate dress is required. This includes wearing footwear and shirt/top.



PRIVACY

Respect others' privacy and personal space.



ANIMALS

Companion animals are welcome at the Library



SIGNAGE

Users must comply with all posted signage within the Library.
