# Australian Commonwealth Military Forces World War I Honour Roll - Victoria District (Geraldton, Greenough, Walkaway and Mullewa)

Following the Great War (1914-1918), numerous Honour Boards commemorating the fallen from the Victoria District were erected. In many instances, local records were not kept and instead relatives were invited to nominate their kin for remembrance.

The following list recognises soldiers who were resident or enlisted in Geraldton, Greenough, Walkaway and Mullewa and who died in service to their country, either in action, from wounds, or from other causes directly connected with the Great War, up until 1921. Honour Boards were used as the foundation for this list, respecting the original wishes of grieving families.

Further records were then cross-checked against those held by the Australian Archives, Commonwealth War Graves Commission, AIF Project (UNSW Australia) and the Australian War Memorial.
